

State 4-H Bicycle Rodeo Questions

The following questions will be the basis for the State 4-H Bicycle Rodeo quizzes.

- The Junior quiz will contain a total of 15 multiple choice questions.
- The Senior quiz will contain a total of 25 true-false, multiple choice, and fill in the blank questions.

NOTE: The questions may be slightly modified. For example, the multiple choice answers may be rearranged so that "C" is the correct answer, not "A."

TRUE-FALSE

1. At a corner where traffic is heavy, it is best to dismount from your bicycle before reaching the intersection and use the crosswalks as a pedestrian instead of making a left turn while driving. T
2. Seventy-five percent of all bicycle-motor vehicle accidents are the result of failure to follow traffic rules. T
3. A safe place to pass a slow moving vehicle is at an intersection. F
4. Pedestrians have the right-of-way over a bicyclist on sidewalks. T
5. According to Indiana state law, it is permissible to operate bicycles with only one hand on the handlebars while carrying a package in the other hand. F
6. When riding a bicycle on a road there should be no more than two (2) bicyclists riding abreast (side-by-side). T
7. Every bicycle operated on a public highway from one half (½) hour before sunrise shall be equipped with a light on the front exhibiting a white light visible from a distance of at least five hundred (500) feet. T

10. When traffic is light, it is legal to slow down and coast through an intersection controlled by a yield sign. T
