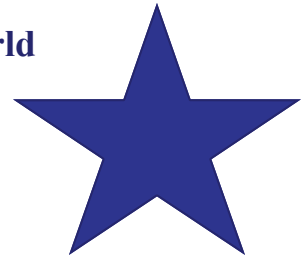

Driving Directions

To the Holiday Inn North-Lexington:

1950 Newtown Pike, Lexington, KY

Traveling South on I-75 and/or traveling East on I-64:

I-75 and I-64 will merge once they both reach the Lexington city limits. Exit at #115, and turn right. At the first stoplight, take a left onto Coleman Road and into the Holiday Inn parking lot.

To the Rolling Hills Equestrian Center East:

5380 Troy Pike, Versailles, KY

Approximate Travel Time: 20-30 minutes

From the Hotel:

Turn Left at the light from the hotel onto Newtown Pike/KY-922. Follow Newtown Pike to New Circle Road (KY-4). Enter New Circle Road from the right. Follow KY-4 to Versailles Road (US 60) and take the first exit, going away from Lexington. Follow US 60 to the Martha Layne Collins Bluegrass Parkway, approximately 6 miles. In about 3 miles, take exit #68 Kentucky 33-turn left. Rolling Hills will be about 3 miles on your left.
