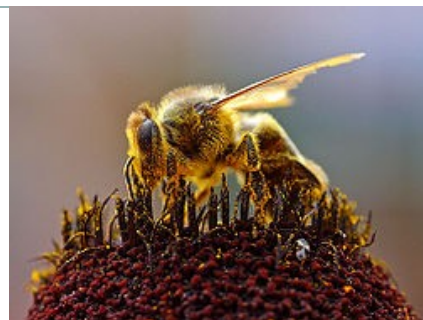


2012 4-H BEEKEEPING ESSAY CONTEST

Topic: **The Results of Honey Bee Pollination in my Community**

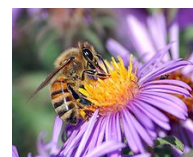
